

Implemented Activities from Mid-March 2020 to Early April 2020

- Permit to implement the project ***“Promoting a thriving market of Modern Energy Cooking Services in Tanzania”*** has been applied from President Office Regional Administration and Local Government, it waits for approval. The granted approval will direct and allow Regional and district/ Municipal leaders to support the project implementation their levels.
- The technical personnel have started studying the science and engineering of the Electric Pressure cookers, as to come up with appropriate means to provide the after sales services, the technical manual for troubleshooting, this will ensure more confidence of the product to be marketed.
- Market intelligence on where to source the EPC has led us into identifying and having direct contacts with one of manufacturer of the EPC in China. As a way to promote a thriving market of EPC in Tanzania, a very first consignment of rotary dial EPCs rebranded SESCOM will be shipped and introduced to the market by May 2020.
- TaTEDO through her social enterprise SESCOM has participated in the Global Leap Award Competition, where by EPC product with brand name ***SESCOM*** was proposed for the competition.
- Awareness creation continued using various materials including leaflets with different educative information. ***(See flier in the next page)***

Planned Activities

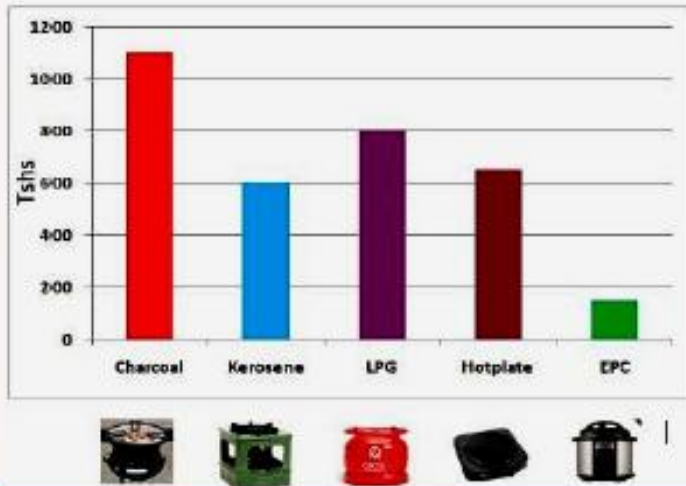

Electric Pressure Cooker (EPC)

Efforts were made to know if anything could beat an Electric Pressure Cooker (EPC) on cost, so we boiled 500g of yellow beans as carefully as we could on charcoal, kerosene, LPG, an electric hot plate and on EPC.

All the tricks in the book were applied—lids on the sufurias turning down to a simmer, just enough water, etc. However, we still couldn't get close to an EPC.

Not only was it thirteen times cheaper than charcoal, it cooked in half the time without any stirring or topping up of water or fuels
